The Library

The Little Library is in Mill Road, in the former Telephone Box and is cared for by The Community Association. You are welcome to borrow books from the library and you will also find a notice board inside the library. Other notice boards are by the post box in Mill Road, in Low Road West and in Low Road East.

Recycling

The Village Recycling Scheme, organised by The Parish Council, is run by a group of volunteers who sort and recycle scrap metal. The metal is then taken to a merchant and sold to raise funds for village projects. If you have any scrap metal please donate it to the scheme, by delivering it to the farmyard in Low Road West.

NB this scheme is for scrap metal only. No other items are accepted for recycling.

Local Businesses and Services

Numerous local businesses can be found in the village, some advertise in the Mardle but a comprehensive list of local businesses and services can be found on the Parish Council website.

Post Offices

The Main Post Office is in Quebec Street in Dereham, there is a post office in Hockering, open on weekdays from 9am-5.30pm on weekdays and from 9am-12am on Saturdays. There are sub post offices at Mattishall and Swanton Morley, open mornings only. Post boxes are in Mill Road and Low Road East.

Bus Service

There is currently no bus service in the village, although the public are allowed to use the no8 school bus operated by Konnect. See the Konnect bus timetable on their website for pick up points and times. The Parish Council and the Community Association are working together to try to get a bus service for the village.

The Common

The Common, accessed from Pound Lane, is a county wildlife site and is cared for by a group of volunteers, supported by The Parish Council. It is one of the many places to walk in the village, a map of the local footpaths can be found on the noticeboard at Pound Corner, in the Little Library, and on the Parish Council website.
